Disabled Access information for the 2016 festival venues

Blackheath Halls

All public areas at Blackheath Halls are fully accessible, with lift access to the first floor venue. We advise anybody with specific needs to advise of their visit in advance where possible and to introduce themselves to the Duty Manager upon arrival to ensure a smooth and positive experience. Customers are welcome to drop off individuals with access requirements at the venue and then make their way to a car parking space. There are some disabled parking bays on Lee Terrace and Lee Park Road. If these are full, the nearest parking spaces are located in the car park at the back of Blackheath Station or in the small car park near the Post Office. Please allow plenty of time for parking

All Saints Church

Parking for disabled visitors with a blue badge permit. There are single yellow lines outside the front on both sides, which rarely have more than one car on them.

We have full disabled access through the North Porch where there is also an accessible toilet.

We have a ramp leading to the front door but the lintel may not be suitable for larger scooters.

There is full disability access.

St Michael & All Angels Church

There is disabled access into church

There is a marked disabled parking bay at the beginning of Pond Road, immediately next to the Pond Road church gate and path, which lead directly into church.

There is a sloped pathway with a handrail on the north side of church and a wooden ramp in the north porch leading directly into church.

There is a disabled toilet in the church hall

St Margaret's Church

We can accommodate a vehicle in the driveway or disabled badge holders may park on the yellow lined roads immediately around the church (not in the residents bays as you will get a ticket).

Externally we have ramped access to upstairs and downstairs and there is a wheelchair accessible toilet in the Crypt. We have a lift to take wheelchairs between floors, which should fit a small mobility scooter. In the unlikely event the scooter is too big for the lift, we can access the Crypt and toilet via the external ramps.
